

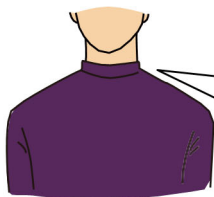
# ◆◆◆◆◆ Acceptable attire ◆◆◆◆◆



- ★ Shirts should be sleeved with a fold-down or turtleneck collar.  
(For women, sleeveless and high-necked shirts with collars of 4 cm or more are also acceptable.)
- ★ If worn, shorts should be above the knees.
- ★ Skirts and culottes must be no more than 10 cm above the knees.

- ★ Shirt tails are to be tucked into one's pants or skirt.
- ★ Socks should be either knee length or just covering the ankles when wearing shorts.

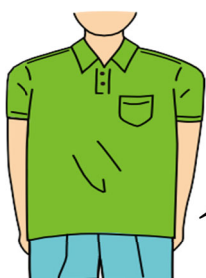
# ◆◆◆◆◆ Unacceptable attire ◆◆◆◆◆



Collarless shirts  
(T-shirts, sweatshirts, high-necked shirts, etc.)  
(For women, tank tops, camisoles, etc.)  
★ However, women may wear high-necked tops if the collar is at least 4 cm.

Color: Flashy or fluorescent colors, etc.

Pattern: Flamboyant use of logos or camouflage design



## Untucked shirts

★ For women, shirt tails designed to be worn over pants or skirts are allowed.



## Exposure of underwear

(Wearing long-sleeved underwear under short-sleeved polo shirts)

Short socks that do not cover the ankles



Jersey, jeans, cargo pants, etc.  
(with bulging pockets)

# Maintaining our sartorial traditions...

Clothing is an integral part of the tradition and culture of our club, and we require that your attire conforms to the atmosphere of our club when you visit, play, and use the clubhouse. Therefore, please consider the color, pattern, design, and suchlike of your sartorial choices to maintain the traditional standards of our club.

We adhere to the following dress code. We request that members carefully explain the details to their guests in advance to avoid misunderstanding or discomfort, since members and guests wearing unacceptable clothing may be asked to adjust their attire, which may cause embarrassment. We therefore request that members and guests familiarize themselves with these rules in order to enjoy a pleasant round.

## Kasumigaseki Dress Code

### While in the clubhouse, before and after playing a round...

#### Jacket, shirts, and pants

- ◎ Please wear a jacket (blazer) when arriving at the clubhouse entrance. Blouses and jumpers are not permitted.
- ◎ Styling should be equivalent to business casual. Please wear a shirt with a fold-down or turtleneck collar. Shirt tails must be tucked into pants.
- ◎ Shorts are not permitted upon arrival.

#### Footwear

- ◎ Sneakers (with white or flashy colored soles), sandals, mules, and golf shoes are not permitted upon arrival.

### On the course...

#### Pants and skirts

- ◎ Knee-length socks or short socks covering the ankles are required if wearing shorts while playing. Wearing sports underwear in layers with your shorts are not permitted. In addition, shorts must be above the knees. Shorts that are too long or too short are not permitted.
- ◎ Women's miniskirts, hot pants, spats, leggings, etc. are not permitted.  
Golf skirts and culottes must be no more than 10 cm above the knees.
- ◎ Cargo pants (with bulging pockets), denim jeans, etc., as well as extremely colorful clothing, camouflage patterns, and decorations that are overly conspicuous are not permitted.

#### Shirts and others

- ◎ Please wear a shirt with sleeves and a fold-down or turtleneck collar. (Women may wear sleeveless and/or high-necked shirts with collars of at least 4 cm.)
- ◎ T-shirts, sweatshirts, high-necked shirts, and stand-up collars are unacceptable. For women, tank tops, camisoles, or overly revealing attire are not allowed. If you raise the back of your shirt collar while playing, please fold it back down in the clubhouse.
- ◎ Wearing long-sleeved underwear (including those made of high-tech materials) under short-sleeved golf shirts is not permitted. Please simply cover such underwear with a long-sleeved shirt if necessary.  
Protective arm covers are allowed on the course, but not in the clubhouse.
- ◎ Please tuck your shirt tails into your pants. For women, shirt tails designed to be worn over one's pants or skirt are allowed. However, overly short shirts that expose the abdomen are not permitted.
- ◎ In order to avoid risk, please wear appropriate headwear on the course. Please remove any hats in the clubhouse.

#### Dress etiquette

- ◎ In the dining room, please remove your hat, and other weather-related attire used when it is hot, cold, rainy, or windy, such as rainwear, jumper, windbreaker, down or quilted vest.
- ◎ During the heat of summer, profuse perspiration may cause discomfort in the dining room. Please consider changing into a fresh golf shirt and pants before seating out of respect for other diners.
- ◎ Towels must not be hung around the neck, shoulders, or belt at any time.
